Charter's May 2016 acquisition of Time Warner Cable and Bright House Networks, with a reported value of about \$67 billion, has led to a shuffling of its workforce in Charlotte, where thousands of employees (the company declined to provide specific figures) work in finance, human resources, customer service and other departments. In fall 2016, Charter reported 258 layoffs in its local accounting and finance division. The recent 2017 expansion "involved multiple functions during the year," a company spokesman says.

Gov. Roy Cooper called it the largest manufacturing investment ever in rural North Carolina when the project was announced in December. Site work began in the spring for a plant at the Kingsboro megasite that will eventually produce 6 million tires a year. The plant will initially make tires for passenger vehicles; a second phase will add a facility for making commercial tires. The average annual wage will be \$56,450, 73% higher than Edgecombe's average of \$32,600. Triangle Tyre also considered Georgia's Laurens County for the plant.


